





A New Entrance to Offshore Fishing



It will be interesting to watch the future development of the Bribie Island Breakthrough in the coming months. There have been fears of increased tidal range, higher levels of foreshore erosion and a potential increase in local flooding issues as a result of the increase in height between the high and low tide. There are indications that the existing Caloundra bar is gradually becoming shallower which could result in the sand building up to a point where the tip of Bribie may become part of Caloundra. I understand that one of the main areas of concern is the possibility of wave propagation onto Golden beach.

What ever the outcome, Caloundra Bar is notoriously dangerous and the main entrance has changed as a result of the breakthrough, so make sure you are well informed before attempting a crossing.
