

I really felt sorry for Jim when he realised that these fish were also called Slatey Bream and his fish was just not big enough.



Maroochydore Competition

13th – 15th May 2022

The Club is conducting its weekend away fishing competition for Maroochy River fishers and socializers at Maroochydore 13-15 May 2022. Hopefully members will catch plenty of good quality fish of many species such as bream, flathead, trevally, cod, whiting, mangrove jack and more. Maroochydore is approximately 1.5 hours' drive from Bribie Island.



How to get there

For those familiar with the internet, have a look at “Google” using your search engine. Google will show one route up the Bruce H’way turning right at the Nambour connection on to Maroochydore Road, travelling through Kunda Park, turning left onto Main Road a little past Kunda Park, left again at a Y junction on to Fisherman’s Road and then up to a T junction at Bradman Avenue. Turn left here into David Low Way and look for Maroochy River Resort and Bungalows at 38-46 David Low Way. Another route you may wish to consider is to turn off the Bruce Highway onto the Sunshine Motorway just after Palmview and head towards Mooloolabah.

Turn left just before Mooloolabah and follow the Sunshine Motorway towards Maroochydore. Prior to the bridge over the Maroochy River, go off the Sunshine Motorway and onto Bradman Avenue heading for Diddillibah. Continue on Bradman Avenue on David Low Way. 

The cost of the 2 nights' accommodation has been subsidized by the Club. Given the monies you have already paid, you do not have to dip into your pockets again for Friday and Saturday nights' accommodation.

If you wish to extend your stay at the park outside of the Friday and Saturday nights, then you **need to make your own arrangements with Maroochy River Resort and Bungalows including payment of the extra stays.**

The Bungalows have linen for the main bed and one single

The experience of those who have participated in this Maroochy competition previously and who have stayed at Maroochy River Resort is that you should be able to access your cabins reasonably early in the afternoon so getting there around about lunch time should not be a problem.

Please note that we must vacate the bungalows/cabins and check out by midday.

What is happening

Places have been booked at the Waterfront Hotel on the deck for 6.30 pm on Friday night. The hotel is only 5 or so minutes' walk from the cabins. ***The club will not subsidize dinner expenses.***

See below for all to do with the fishing competition aspects.

Dinner on Saturday night will be at the pub at 6pm. ***The Club will meet the cost of this dinner.*** The presentation will commence at the pub immediately after dinner or during sweets.

All other meals and nibbles are by your own arrangement.

Fishing competition

Fishing commences at 6am and finishes at 4pm on Saturday. Weigh-in on Saturday is at 4pm in front of the waterfront bungalows. **If you are weighing in your catch, you must be at the weigh-in point by the weigh-in time.** The presentation will be on the Saturday night.

Please ensure you check the size and take limits applicable to each of the species. If you have the internet go to <https://www.daf.qld.gov.au/fisheries/recreational/rules-regulations/size-possession-limits-tidal> It is your responsibility to check for yourselves.

The competition will be contested with a ladies' category and a men's category for heaviest bags caught, and combination of the categories for biggest fish. The prizes will be for each category, the heaviest bag 1st, 2nd, 3rd; for combined categories, the biggest fish and second biggest fish of any species for the competition; and a lucky draw for those who did not get to weigh a fish. These prizes are the same as those for the competition last year. The competition allows for the weigh in of up to and including your best 5 of each species.

Bait Restrictions

Because of the White Spot disease and subsequent Movement Control Order, we do need to be careful of where fresh bait has come from. The zone for the Movement Control Order for White Spot stretches from the NSW border to Caloundra. This means that any prawns, crabs, yabbies and marine worms etc caught in the control zone cannot be taken outside of the zone and used as fresh bait. Also, any fresh bait caught outside of the control zone, taken into the zone for whatever reason and then taken out again, cannot then be used as bait in that area. So – what to do – pump your yabbies, catch your worms and source your other fresh bait north of Caloundra. 
